2. Why Interoperability for the Social and Solidarity Economy?

- enables to operate effectively together.
- enables to automatically interpret the information exchanged meaningfully and accurately to produce useful results as defined by the end-users of both systems.
- ensures data sovereignty: a system keeps control over its data.
- a system is able to communicate with its peer.
