# Spanish Context (National Background)

- Strong cooperative tradition
- Active social dialogue with high collective bargaining coverage
- Advanced voluntary sustainability reporting



# Spanish Context (National Background) II

- Limited scope of Sustainability legislation (autonomous regions)
- Banking: digitalization not excluding seniors, rural communities
- Retail: carbon footprints, long value chains
- Agriculture: resource consumption and replacing farmers.



# COVAP–Agricultural Sustainability and Social Impact

- Integrated cooperative governance ("360-degree" approach: farm-to-market)
- Pioneering environmental initiatives (methane reduction, renewable energy, zero waste)
- Significant territorial impact supporting 10,000+ jobs and rural populations
- "Juntos en el círculo": proactive supplier sustainability programme



# Cajamar – Sustainability in Financial Services

- Social and environmental sustainability ingrained since foundation
- Example of cooperative integration: growth while maintaining cooperative values and operational principles
- Deep rural presence enhancing financial inclusion
- Innovative green finance solutions (eco-loans, green bonds)



# EROSK+ Cooperative Retail Innovation

- Pioneering sustainable value chains (extensive scope and depth)
- Active member of cooperative network Mondragon, balancing growth with cooperative principles
- Democratic governance structure involving equal consumer and worker participation
- Local Supplier Support Programme: boosts regional economy and trust



# Cross Sector Lessons Learned

- Cooperative governance enhances long-term sustainability and resilience
- Social dialogue is a critical driver of innovation and adaptability
- Active stakeholder participation crucial for effective sustainability due diligence
- Key sectors in polycrisis (intrinsic values and double regulation) > central role 4 cooperatives.
